









## **MATERIALS PROVIDED**

Empty Specimen Container | Nail Specimen Bag | Biohazard Bag with Pocket

## **CLINICAL PROCEDURE**

- Label bag or container with patient name, date of birth, and source site.
- Place collected nail(s) into nail specimen bag or container. Dry nail specimens (clippings) should be submitted in a nail bag or empty plastic jar. However, nails with any soft tissue or clot attached should be submitted in formalin jars to preserve the soft tissue component from drying out.
- 3. Place container or specimen bag into biohazard bag. Multiple bags or containers from the same patient can be submitted in the same biohazard bag.
- 4. Place paper copies of face-sheets and requisitions into pouch on biohazard bag.
- 5. Please verify that Patient Name and Birthdate (or other second unique identifier, such as patient id#) on req match those on the specimen container.
- 6. Place completed biohazard bag into provided laboratory box/pack for shipping/pickup.
- 7. Seal the mailer and place a shipping label on the outside.
- 8. Place laboratory box/pack in the designated area for shipping/pickup.
- 9. If shipping/pickup is needed and not already scheduled, please call the lab.
